

## Fish in the Sea

### Background

Cut Square size:  
5 1/2" x 5 1/2"

Cut: 42#  
Includes enough for fish tail (see next page)

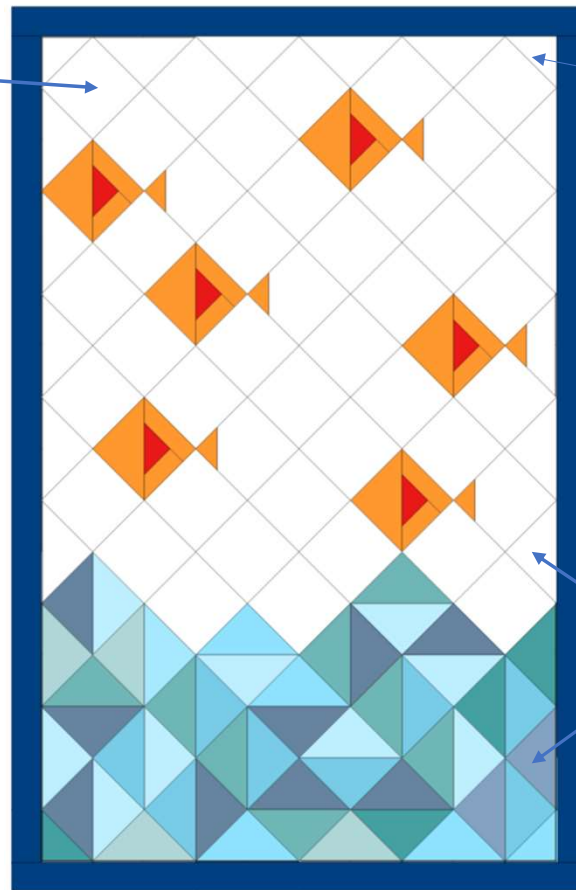
Fabric Requirement (WOF):  
1 1/2 yards

### Sea

Cut Square Size:  
6" x 6" then cross-cut  
once (HSTs)



Cut 20# squares, cross-cut,  
mix fabrics, and sew back  
together to create 20#  
squares @ 5 1/2 x 5 1/2



### Corner Triangles

Cut Square Size:  
6 1/4" x 6 1/4"

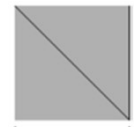


Then cross-cut twice

Cut:  
1 each Background & Sea (need 2  
of each)

### Side Setting Triangles

Cut Square Size:  
6" x 6" then cross-cut  
once (HSTs)



Background: Cut 7# (need 14)

Sea: Cut 4# (need 8)

2" Border – may need piecing  
2 @ 2.5" x 40.5"  
2 @ 2.5" x 57.5"

### Fish Body Cutting Instructions

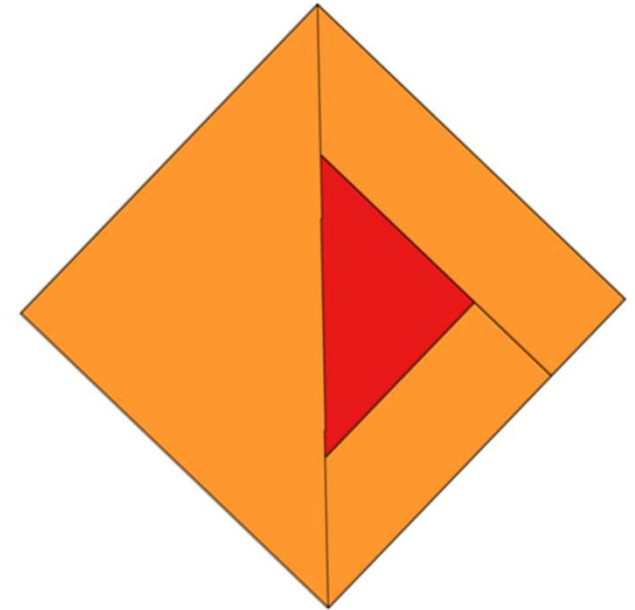
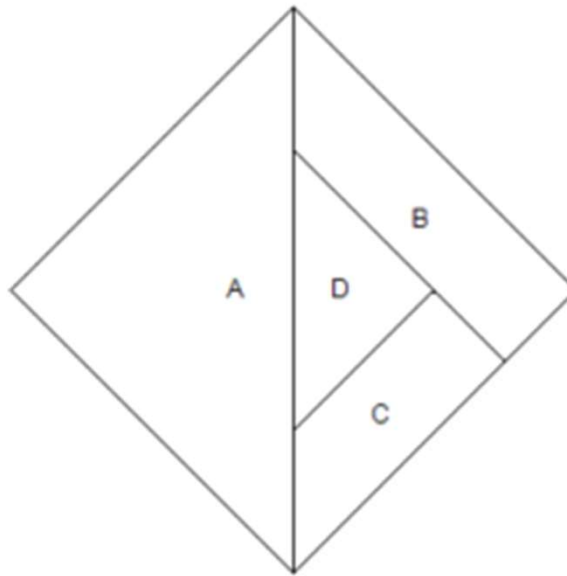
Part A: Cut 3 squares at 6" x 6", cross-cut once to create HSTs



Part B – Cut 6 strips @ 1 3/4" x 6"

Part C – Cut 6 strips @ 1 3/4" x 6"

Part D – Cut 3 squares at 3 1/2" x 3 1/2" then cross-cut once to create 6 HSTs



### Assembly

Assemble parts B, C and D as shown in diagram

Sew to Part A

Trim square to 5 1/2" x 5 1/2"

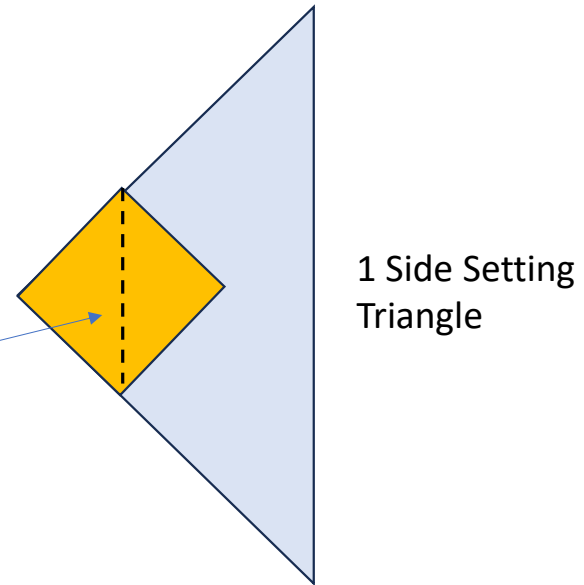
Fish Tail (6 Fish)

Background squares included in Background cut

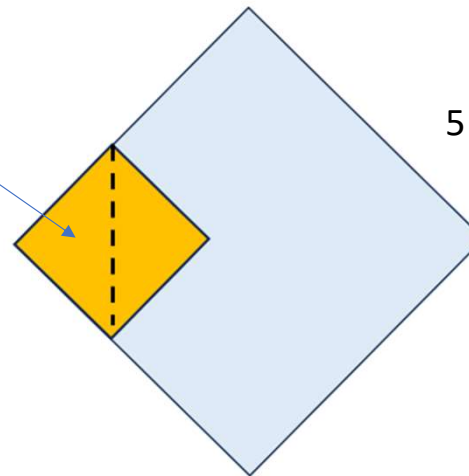
Tail fabric:  
Cut 6 squares @ 3" x 3"

Line up background square and sew diagonal line as shown

Trim & flip to create tail block
